

Financial Aid Issues to Consider When Applying to
Sharon Regional Health System
School of Nursing

Please take the time to consider all of the following information.

You will be considered a first year student when you attend Sharon Regional Health System School of Nursing which means your financial aid eligibility will be reduced to first year, first time student status. Full time employment during a full time program is discouraged.

1. Are you currently enrolled in pre-requisite courses at another university or college?
2. Have you applied for aid while attending another university or college?
3. Have you added Sharon Regional Health System, School of Nursing to your current FAFSA? School Code – 006578
4. Has the university or college you are attending used a portion of your financial aid for the current year?
5. If a portion of your financial aid has been used and you do not have enough to cover your tuition and fees at SRHS, do you have an alternate plan of payment?
6. If you do not need additional financial aid (as in an over award, additional money that gets paid back to you), please consider not accepting any portion over and above your tuition costs. Doing this will allow you more eligibility when you begin classes here in January.
7. Sharon Regional Health System School of Nursing is a clock hour school, which does not follow the same rules of larger universities and colleges. We cannot disburse your financial aid until 30 days after the start of classes in January. How will you pay for your books, uniforms, etc.?
8. Based on your financial, marital or employment status, have you considered checking into CareerLink (724-347-9257 – Mercer County, 724-656-3165 – Lawrence County), Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (724-347-9257 – Mercer County, 724-656-3070 – Lawrence County) in Pennsylvania or Ohio Job & Family Services (330-747-5639 – Mahoning County, 330-424-7722 – Columbiana County, 330-675-7710 – Trumbull).
